

#### **Excutive Sumary**

Our major fund source is from Mengly J. Quach Education, Q & Q and other donation from teachers/students and outsiders. Through collaboration with NGOs and local authorities, Mengly J. Quach Foundation Organization have smoothly implemented which is demonstrates that the industry has made significant progress toward comprehending the necessity of proper production that benefited to 8,283 families which is equal to 41,415 peoples of 24,849 women including 12, 425 children of 7,455 girls (most of them are vulnerable, poor and elders).

From January to December 2019, there are 15 projects among 20 projects within 04 programs of Mengly J. Quach Foundation have been implemented which is benefited to 41,415 people including 24,849 females and 12,425 children. This included 06 projects of Education program implemented which is benefited to 12, 998 students and participants (7,799 females) such as Children's Bikes project for Education benefited to 84 children, Mengly J. Quach Public School Construction project for 2,948 students, Mengly J. Quach Scholarship project to 13 students, Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library project to 1,700 students, Teaching and Learning Quality project to 5,948 students and Oknha Dr. Mengly J. Quach's Charity Workshop project benefited to 2,305 participants.



And 04 projects in Health program are implemented that benefited to 15,054 people of 9,032 woman and girls. Those project are: Health Emergency Responses project benefited to 16 illness people, Mengly J. Quach Blood Banking project of 14 volunters donated, Dr. Quach Mobile Medical


Clinic project benefited to 354 people and Health Infrastructure Construction project benefited to 1,4670 people and children.

Lastly is Community Service program of 5 projects is operated to 13,363 beneficiaries (8,018 female) such as Emergency Responses project benefited to 301 people, Mengly J. Quach Food Banking project benefited to 2, 481 people, Community Construction project benefited to 3,764 people, Gift In Kinds benefited to 6, 805 people and Smart Startup benefited to 12 people.

#### I. Major Accomplishments:

#### 1. Education Program

Based on annual plan and budget in 2019, Mangly J. Quach Foundation has cooperated with NGOs partners, local authority and relevant institution implementing six projects of education program with 12,998 of benificairies; located in Phnom Penh capital city, Kampong Cham, Pursat, Kampong Chhnang, Kampong Speu Kratie and Prey Veng Provinces.



#### 1.1 Children's Bikes for Education Project: (CBE):

Children's Bikes for Education 10th and 11th is benefited to 89 poor students which is included 79 vulnerable families (orphan, elder, scrab collectors and garment factory) who are living at Sangkat Khmounh (slum area), Khan Sensok of Phnom Penh city on September 17, 2019 and to 05 students at Yukunthor primary school of Kampong Chhnang province.



1.2 Mengly J. Quach Public School Construction Project(MJQPSC):

The textbook curriculum and learning environment are regarded as the fourth fundamental principle in the vision for education reform in Cambodia. The construction of additional school buildings is an important part of expanding access to education to improve the learning environment. According to the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport's Education Conference 2016, about 5,000 school buildings need urgent renovations and renovations. The Ministry of Education has called on the Prime Minister and other stakeholders to help build the schools. At the same time, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation also plans to build school and also set up education facilities in rural provinces that are in need in Cambodia.



In 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has supported school facilities to the targeted school within the provinces with total of 2,940 beneficiaries:

- Donated 50,000,000 riels to Quach Mengly Tuol Beng Primary School with a total of 344 students located in Krola commune, Kampong Siem district, Kampong Cham province to organize a tile floor in two classrooms.
- During the month of June 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation in collaboration with American Intercon School, Toul Kork Branch, brought \$ 1650 to construct a two-room toilet with two rooms and two flower gardens for Teak Primary School with a total of 633 students. In Russey Keo commune, Peam Chor district, Prey Veng province
- In August 2019, the Mengly J. Foundation has donated \$ 2,937 to Chak Angre Primary School for constructing a school building which has 1,351 students located in Tampaing commune, Phnom Sruoch district, Kampong Speu province.
- At the 5th Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly Charity Workshop at Phnom Pros Hotel, Kampong Cham Province, Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly, Executive Director of the Mengly J. Quach Foundation has donated \$ 1,000 to Chheu Kleum Primary School with 526 students located in Chhmar Khmum Village, Romchek Commune, Memot District, Tbong Khmum Province for constructing of a two-room schoolhouse built of galvanized steel.
- Also in 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation has partnered with Aii Language Center supported \$ 4,000 for building a toilet of 3 rooms at Koh Rok Ko Primary School which is benefited to 94 students located in the village of Achong, Samrong commune, Phnom Kravanh district of Pursat province.



#### 1.3 Mengly J. Quach Scholarship (MJQS):

To address the barriers to inclusion of underprivileged students from the provinces to continue their studying, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation has established the Mengly J. Quach Scholarship program in order to financially support to poor students for higher education that is benefit of themselves and society in the future. The Scholarship Selection Committee conducts an in-depth analysis of "underprivileged students" and identifies strengths and areas they are interested in studying to

develop their careers. Anyway, there are 10 (new scholarships) and three alumni, so the total number of scholarships for 2019 is 13, including one monk.



1.4 Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library (MJQML):

Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library project is a general education outreach project implemented by the Mengly J. Quach Foundation to support those students who cannot access such materials in remote areas of Cambodia. This project is designed to benefit rural communities with a lack of educational materials, such as reading books, comidy, force tell story comics, illustrations. Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library is aims to create opportunities and opportunities for students, as well as community children, to participate in extracurricular activities in public schools, such as reading books, storytelling, drawing. In addition to the above activities, the Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library project is also donates educational materials to students and donates teaching materials to libraries, schools, community libraries and associations.



In 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation implemented the 9th Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library project that benefited to 1,700 students at Phnom Penh. Six times of Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library

conducted with 1,212 beneficiaries such as 7 Village Primary School, Toul Kork Primary School, Children's Restaurant and Save the Children Asia organizations. Furthermore, we also conducted 2 times of Mobile Library in Kandal province at Taip Primary School and Mlop Children's Home with 262 beneficiaries, and one each at Kompong Chhnang Primary School with 226 beneficiaries.

#### 1.5 Teaching and Learning Quality (TLQ):

The Teaching and Learning Quality Project is one of six new educational programs designed by the Mengly J. Quach Foundation's team launched in early 2019 and officially approved by Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly, Executive Director of the Mengly J. Quach Foundation in June 11, 2019. The project aims to encourage students and children in the community to be eager to learn and learn, to promote and improve the Cambodian education system.

During the implementation of the quality, training and study activities from January to December 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation has distributed teaching and learning materials of 12 times to different location with a total of 5,948 beneficiaries in six different target areas including Phnom Penh such as Phnom Penh, Kandal, Kampong Speu, Pursat, Kampong Cham and Prey Veng. The implementation of this project is as follows donation of a textbook by Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly to state institutions and civil society organizations Funding for infrastructure development work on campus.



1.6 Oknha Dr. Mengly J. Quach's Charity Workshop (MJQCW):

The Oknha Dr. Mengly J. Quach Charity Workshop is one of the six projects among Education Program of Mengly J. Quach Foundation. This project is designed with the aim of sharing the

knowledge and know-how for the next generation of young people to prepare and choose the right topics for higher education and to raise funds for social work.


Charitable giving or sponsorship for the elderly, defenseless, vulnerable families in remote areas, or to support such education as construction of school buildings, educational materials, teaching materials. Mengly J. Quach Foundation has been working with companies, national organizations, international organizations, universities and young entrepreneurs to organize charity workshops to young people, students, educational institutions, staff, companies and organizations both in Phnom Penh and in the provinces of Cambodia over presided by Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly, Founder, Chairman and CEO of Mengly J. Quach Education. Keynote speaker at the charity workshop. In addition to the seminars in the country, Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly has also been honored as guest speakers at overseas seminars such as South Korea, Thailand and so on.

To date, the report of Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly's charity workshop project has been carried out six times with a total of 2,305 students, teachers, students, staff, and organizations in four provinces: Siem Reap, Battambang, Kampong Cham and Phnom Penh.



#### 2. Health Program

From January to December 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation has been implementing four of the five projects of Health Program with a total of 15,054 beneficiaries. Mengly J. Quach Foundation implemented those 4 projects in Phnom Penh, Banteay Meanchey, Battambang, Kampot, Kampong Chhnang. Preah Vihear, Kratie, Prey Veng and Kandal provinces.



#### 2.1 Health Emergency Responses (HER):

Mengly J. Quach Foundation aims to promote healthy livelihoods in a number of communities throughout Cambodia. The Foundation has been working in conjunction with health initiatives to ensure that the poorest students, the elderly, the orphans and the most vulnerable, receive better access to health care and disease treatment services.





In 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has spent about \$ 30,304 on Health Emergency Response project, providing support to 16 patients and more than 250 family members. Our support, seeking the disease treatment of all 16 patients, included the cancer patients, heart-attack patients, toxi goiter patients, gynecologists, traffic accident and others. Most notably, found the devastating news

of the building collapse in Sihanoukville in June 2019, through the Cabinet of the Council of Ministers, Mengly J. Quach Foundation donated \$ 10,000 to the families of the 28 victims who got deaths of building collapse and families of 26 victims who got injured in the brutal accident. In addition, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has monthly donated \$ 2,000 to the Ambulance Unit of National Road No 4 in the purpose to supprort daily expenses of the unit.

#### 2.2 Mengly J. Quach Blood Banking (MJQBB):

Aiming to contribute in the social welfare promoting and humaniterian action, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has been deeply involved and collaborating with the Royal Government of Cambodia, especially Health Agencies, in facilitating the disease treatment of the vulnerable and seeking internal and external resources to save those in need.



In 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has mobilized 14 volunteered blood donors and donated 14 pints of blood to rescue lives of 3 patients, including Ms Chea Sokhary, who sufferred from a terminal illness with the need of 6 boold pints, Ms Pen Chenda, a close friend of Keo Thida, who sufferred from kidney failure and needed regular dialysis and another patient, Mr. Roeun Ra, who was injured in a traffic accident, staying at Preah Kossomak Hospital, was donated six pints of blood.

#### 2.3 Health Infrastructure Construction (HIC):

Mengly J. Quach Foundation has always been supportive of a number of health activities, focusing on directly addressing poverty, vulnerability and emergency response by providing community health services when there is a need or lack of health support. The main purpose of the Health Infrastructure

Construction is to contribute to improving the quality of health, especially contributing to improving the quality of health services and accessibility for vulnerable families and communities.

As the matter of fact, in 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has implemented project activities to




contribute to strengthening health services with the Royal Government. The Foundation constructed a pumping well for Domrey Phong Health Center in Domrey Phong commune, Chhlong district, Kratie province. This pumping well has been benefitted 14,118 people who are always seeking for health services in this health center, and the people who live nearby the center. At the same time, aiming to contribute to the

development of the health sector as well as to increase the number of hospital beds, Mengly J. Quach Foundation donated 23 modern electronic hospital beds to 2 Operational District (Ods), including 13 beds to Tbeng Meanchey Operationa; District in Preah Vihear Province, and 13 beds to Chlong Operational District in Kratie province.

#### 3. Community Services Program

Vulnerable people and communities are protected and enhanced through their community development activities and improved community infrastructure. This program is generally designed for the sustainable development and maintenance of community harmonization in Cambodia. The program aims to contribute to the construction of community infrastructure such as bathrooms, wells, roads, bridges, and providing necessary support such as foodstuffs, clothing and basic necessities to vulnerable people in the communities throughout Cambodia.



From January to December 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has implemented five of the six community service projects with a total of 13,363 beneficiaries located in Phnom Penh, Preah Vihear, Kratie, Kampong Chhnang, Kampong Speu, Preah Sihanouk, Kandal, Prey Veng, Banteay Meanchey and Takeo provinces.

#### 3.1 Emergency Responses (ER)

Mengly J. Quach Foundation contributes to expanding the provision of emergency supports and assistances to the financial hardship and needy in rural communities in Cambodia. The supports given to them are made with the aim of restoring and enhancing the hivelihoods of the vulnerable families. Mengly J. Quach Foundation continues our activities to respond in rural and remote development.





As the virtuality of fact, during the 12 months of the report from January to December 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has carried out its activities of ER project for a total of 301 beneficiaries from several provinces in Cambodia. Known nation wide, seeing the shocking news of the seven-floor building collapse in Sihanoukville that killed 28 workers and 26 got injured, Mengly J. Quach Foundation, throught direction of Oknha Dr. Mengly J. Quach, Executive, donated \$ 10,000 to Cabinet of the Council of Ministers, aiming to help and support the families of the 28 dead victims and 26 injured. Also in 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation supported the construction of a new house for a poor family living in Kampong Leng district, Kampong Chhnang province. At the same time, Mengly J. Quach also supported the renovation of 3 houses for the 3 financial hardship families living in Phnom Penh and Kandal province.

A part from those remarkable achievement recorded, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has been supporting monthly financial to 4 financial hardship students in order to support their daily survival and pursue their education in Phnom Penh. Those are Venerable Nim Chamroeun Prathna, Mr. Sun Thara, Mr. Duong Sorya and Mr. Dara Vichy. Additionally, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has also supported financial 3 patients for daily expenses during their disease treatment.

#### 3.2 Mengly J. Quach Food Banking (MJQFB)

Mengly J. Quach Food Banking is designed to help the poor people and communities in Cambodia and to promote a sharing culture in the communities. MJQFB project aims to increase accessibility to communities with high poverty rates, provide them a clean, nutritious food and educate them on hygiene and eating habits. In addition, we will contribute to the development of food-wasteful communities in order to balance the needs of all. Following the 2019 strategic plan, MJQFB project is regularly conducted at least once a month, especially on every holy day of each month. Since this project established, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has conducted 215 times of this project, with a total of 43,314 beneficiaries.



Report highlighted from January to December 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has conducted 10 times of MJQFB project with a total of 2,241 beneficiaries in 4 provinces, including Phnom Penh, Preah Vihear, Kampong Chhnang and Kampong Speu provinces, mostly donated porridge, packed chicken rice, curry with bread and food packages. Recordingly, in July 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation conducted 212th MJQFB at Sangkat Khmounh, Khan Sen Sok, Phnom Penh, donated 300 food packages to 300 financial hardship families from 5 communities in Khmounh slum area. The food packages to donate to those 300 families are concluded 15,000 kg of Neang Minh rice, 600 kg of salt, 300 kg of sugar, 150 dozens of soy sauce and also donated 5,000,000 riels to 500 families.

#### 3.3 Community Construction (CC)

The Community Construction project is designed to contribute to the development of the community by improving infrastructure and basic needs such as wells, toilets, pagodas, bridges, roads. Since 2004, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has formulated a lot of achievements in terms of building and improving community infrastructure. Many achievements produced by Mengly J. Quach Foundation in Kampong Leng district, Kampong Chhnang province are including: building Sala Chhan, pagoda

gates, constructing ponds in pagoda and community, and 207 square meters of pagoda temple's cell painting. In 2013, Mengly J. Quach Foundation with collaboration with local authorities in Reak Chey commune, Ba Phnom district, Prey Veng province, constructed a bridge of 18 meters long and 4 meters wide, built 13 toilet for 13 villagers, and built 3 pumping wells. Meanwhile, Mengly J. Quach Foundation also supported the purchase of 10 community tables and 100 chairs for community use in Treuy Ngor village, Reak Chey commune, Ba Phnom disstrict, Prey Veng province.



In 2019 reporting period, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has undertaken the Community Construction project to benefit a total of 3,764 beneficiaries, with the remarkable achievement of constructing 1 Sala Chhan at Kirisetharam pagoda, Chronouk commune, Kampong Leng district, Kampong Chhnang province. At the same time, Mengly J. Quach Foundation also donated US \$ 2,000 to build the temple terrace in Thmor Rieng pagoda in Kampong Leng

district, Kampong Chhnang province. Partly, Mengly J. Quach Foundation also contributed financial to the construction of 1 Sala Bon in Sangkum Mean Chey district of Kampong Chhnang province.

#### 3.4 Gift In Kinds (GIK)

Gift in Kinds Project was established in late 2018 and was officially approved by Oknha Dr Mengly J. Quach in mid 2019. GIK project aims to provide material and financial assistance to vulnerable individuals or groups in order to have a dignified life in society.



From the project started, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has implemented the GIK project's activities 2 seperate target areas such as Phnom Penh and Preah Vihear province with a total of 6,805 beneficiaries. In fact, in January 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation's team brought 330 sweaters and 330 boxes of yellow noodles to donate to soldiers stationed at Preah Vihear

temple. And during September 2019, Mengly J. Quach Foundation. donated \$5,000 to the Second Conference on Road Safety, organized by the Ministry of Public Works and Transport in collaboration with the Asia Injury Prevention Foundation. As well, Mengly J. Quach Foundation also donated a new photocopier, costed \$1975 to Sangkat Olympic in Phnom Penh to facilitate their

office work such as copying and printing documents and especially for the convenience of the staff's daily task.

#### 3.5 Smart Start-up (SS)

There is no any diffirent to GIK project, Smart Start-up project was also established in late 2018 and officially approved by Oknha Dr Mengly J. Quach by mid 2019. The purpose of this project is to encourage young Cambodians to use their abilities and talents to initiate new ideas or skills in outstanding business planning.



In 2019, witnessing the creativity of Rubbish Youth of Boeung Trabek arear, Oknha Dr. Mengly J. Quach, through Mengly J. Quach Foundation donated \$ 5,000 and some cafeteria items to these youth group for their smart start-up bussiness of running the green coffee shop.

#### II. Financial Management of Mengly J. Quach Foundation

The total expesnes of Mengly J. Quach Foundation in 2019 is USD \$111,207.89\$ for operating its activities and operations cost which is approximately 50% (fifty percent) donation from Mengly J. Quach Education while the rest 50% (fifty person) is from Q & Q.

Anyway, to ensure the financial stability, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has cooperated with teachers/students and relevant units/departments within Mengly J. Quach Education initiates some fundraising activities for earning ......as extra income:

Set up charity box in all 06 campuses to collect cash and kind Monthly donation of staff and teachers

 Fundraising activities initiated by teachers and students such as food sales, concerts, run for charity and exhibition and so on.

#### III. Challenges

- Baylaw ammentment taking too long because of differences understand of Mol and few members of BoD resided at oversee
- 2. Proposal submission for extra fundraising is not yet done because of Mengly J. Quach Foundation is still consider as a part of MJQE and also is not fully compliance to NGO law
- 3. Lack of transportation is a great challenge for MJQF caused under achievement and effect to annual plan
- 4. Most of outsiders requested for funding support rather than partnership, so MJQF team have implementing its activities by ownself as well as budget spend.
