Cambodian Institute of Child and Adolescent Health (CICAH) is a local non-governmental organization that aims to provide health-related information and services to underprivileged youth, children and mothers in Phnom Penh. The organization was established under the initiative of HE Oknha Dr. Menly J. Quach in 2004 to promote education amongst many disadvantaged children through scholarships.

In order to ensure its activities are more successful, at the end of year 2012, CICAH planned and outlined a clearer objective and mission perspectives until the beginning of 2013, CICAH has since been re-branded to Mengly J. Quach Foundation. In 2013, Mengly J. Quach Foundation officially became a registered organization in the Ministry of Interior with registration number 971, dated June 6, 2013.





We envision a better Cambodian society where most vulnerable and underprivileged population has proper and equal access to education, healthcare, food and other basic necessities so that they live better and their human dignity and values are well protected.

- MJQ Blood Banking Project was 1st launched on July 23, 2013.

MJQ SCHOLARSHIP: MORE THAN A SCHOLARSHIP

Born into a poor family from a remote O'Kreat village, in Kear commune, Maung Russey district, the quiet 21-year-old man with a meek facial expression told Mengly J. Quach Foundation that his name is Euk Nuth, the second of four children in a poor farming family, he said his parents depend on a small field to feed themselves and their children. Despite his family's struggle, Nuth has a dream to become educated and to have a career for the future, so he studied hard and passed his Bac II Examination in 2019. This was the first success of the countryside lad, but more and more obstacles kept appearing in his way. Financial problems and lack of support from his parents prevented Nuth from pursuing higher education. Sadly, he gave up his dream of going to university so that his siblings could also graduate from high school. To help them, Nuth found a job at a local Wing agency, which paid only US \$150 per month. After one year, Nuth, now more eager than ever to study for a college degree, got to know Dr. Quach Mengly through an education program video on MJQTV which led him to seek help from the well-known philanthropist to realize his dream.

"I am so excited because Dr. Mengly has provided me with a full scholarship for 4 years, along with accommodation and a job which allows me to learn a lot more," Nuth said with both smile and tears of joy on his face.

"Life is very different because of the care I received from Dr. Mengly. I have never had the opportunity to pursue my studies due to the lack of support and funds. In my new job, I also have the opportunity to learn new things from my

educated colleagues, especially about professional work and social aspects.

I could hardly even imagine having what I have today. Before, I barely had time to improve my life, but now Dr. Mengly has changed my life by giving me opportunities, support and advice which allowed me to understand myself and know which major and job I would pursue. working hard and overcoming all obstacles because I do not want to disappoint Dr. Mengly and my colleagues.

After hearing Nuth's story and being moved by his commitment to pursue his dream, Dr. Mengly has provided him with a scholarship of USD2,720 which covered four-year tuition for his undergraduate study at Royal University of Phnom Penh's Department of Information Technology and a USD50 monthly allowance from 2021 to 2025. Dr. Mengly also gave Nuth accommodation and an internship at MJQ Education's IT department for him to improve his skills and secure his livelihood.



HEALTH PROGRAM

Mengly J. Quach Foundation helps promote healthy lifestyle in a number of communities throughout Cambodia. We work to link up health initiatives to ensure the students we support are healthy to pursue their education. In addition to that, the MJQ Foundation supports several health activities outside of its core focus that directly address poverty by providing health services to communities where necessary, or lack any health service support. The main purpose of MJQ Health Program is to aim in contributing highly improved health facilities for strengthening the quality of health services and accessibility of the vulnerable family and community.

A DISABLED OF TWICE ACCIDENTS LUCKILY GETS NEW HOME FROM DR. MENGLY

Sitting on a bed in a small house in his 50s, Dith Savy, now in Andong Ta On Village, Sangkat Samrong Krom, Khan Por Senchey, is busy making hammocks for his clients. This is the only way for him to make a living after he was paralyzed in a car accident of many years. He can only make three to four hammocks a day, with each one sold for 3,000 Riels for wholesale and 5,000 Riels for retail. Ever since the COVI-19 pandemic, the business has been suffering.

"The customers have not come to buy my hammock for a few months. Previously, they regularly came here every month. Because of the Covid-19 crisis, they have not made purchases for several months. And now I send it to other people's stalls on the road; otherwise, I would have no income. I can do nothing but making hammocks; I cannot even stand up. I can do nothing but sit on the bed making hammocks, and my wife cannot go to work far from me. Without my wife, I would have been miserable. If this was someone else, she might have run away. People are persuading my wife to leave me, but she never abandons me."

He said that two accidents, a fall from a truck and a motorbike accident, have left him disabled. The former broke his arm and the latter broke his legs. Being handicap is not only a burden to himself but also to his family, who needs to take care of him.



Thanks to the support of the Mengly J. Quach Foundation, a humanitarian and charitable foundation in Cambodia, Savy has received food and clothing aids, as well as a small house from Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly, the founder of Mengly J. Quach Foundation.

"Now that I have such a nice house, I'm so happy," said Savy. "I'm no longer afraid of the flood. In the past, just a little bit of rain, it would be flooded, and most importantly, I would always live with the fear of the wind."

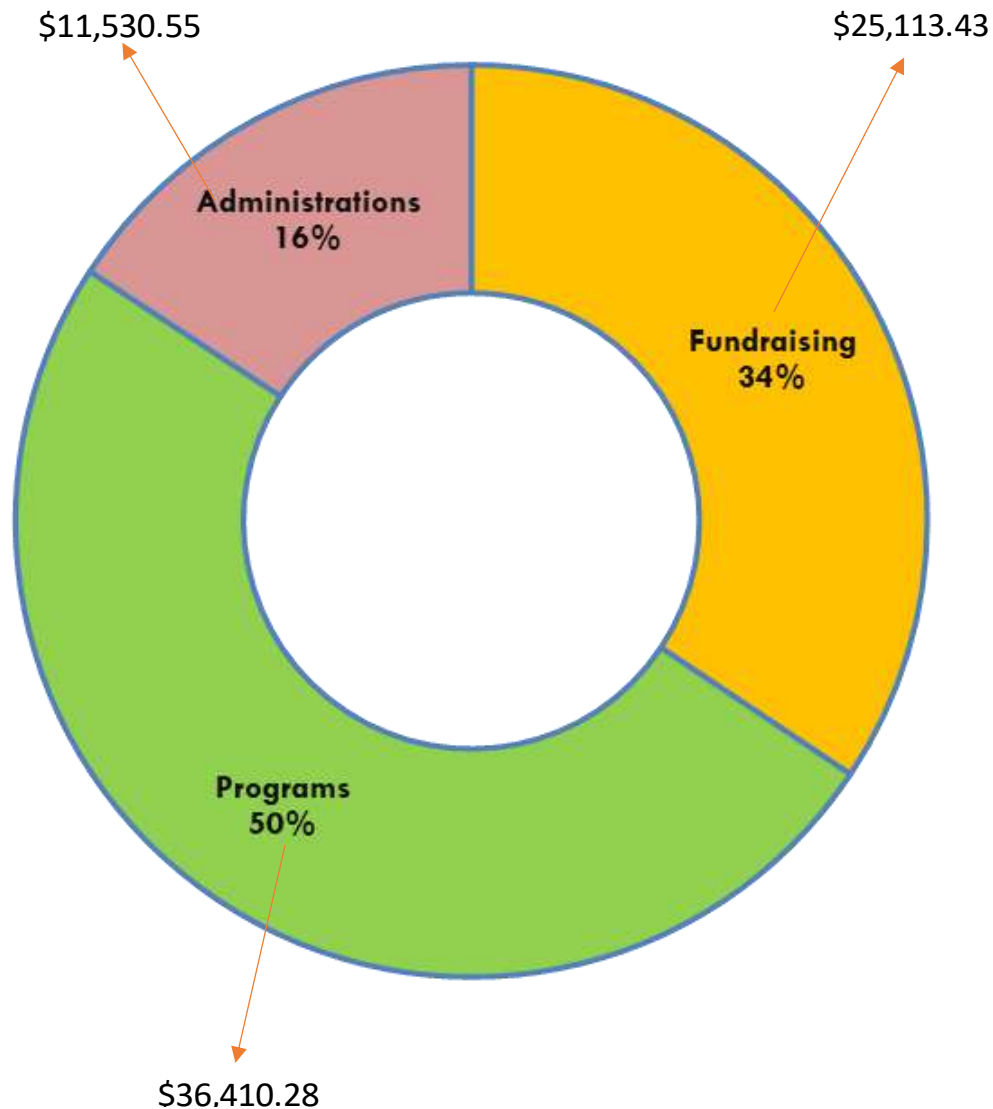
Savy said now he is happier than ever. Before the night came, he always thought that he would not know when he could have the ability to afford the house.

"I used to feel anxious every night, about whether I could have a house with a small income which barely enables me to sustain my living," he added.

He said that he was very grateful to the Mengly J. Quach Foundation and its founder Oknha Dr. Quach Mengly for giving him and his family a new life and saving him from abject poverty.
