OUR HISTORY

Cambodian Institute of Child and Adolescent Health (CICAH) is a local non-governmental organization that aims to provide health-related information and services to underprivileged youth, children and mothers in Phnom Penh. The organization was established under the initiative of HE Oknha Dr. Menly J. Quach in 2004 to promote education amongst many disadvantaged children through scholarships.

In order to ensure its activities are more successful, at the end of year 2012, CICAH planned and outlined a clearer objective and mission perspectives until the beginning of 2013, CICAH has since been re-branded to Mengly J. Quach Foundation. In 2013, Mengly J. Quach Foundation officially became a registered organization in the Ministry of Interior with registration number 971, dated June 6, 2013.





We envision a better Cambodian society where most vulnerable and underprivileged population has proper and equal access to education, healthcare, food and other basic necessities so that they live better and their human dignity and values are well protected.

OUR MILESTONES

- Cambodian Institute of Child and Adolescent Health's name was changed to Mengly J. Quach Foundation Organization (MJQF) with registration No 971 ស.ជ.ណ. of Mol.
- MJQ Blood Banking Project was 1st launched on July 23, 2013.
- MJQ Foundation constructed a 18-meter concrete bridge, 13 toilets and 3 wells in Prey Veng and Takeo province.

Mengly J. Quach Scholarship Project

Mengly J. Quach Scholarship Project was established to provide financial support to the inaccessible and vulnerable students from poor family backgrounds throughout Cambodia. This project assists the needy to continue their studies to reach their full potential and to become competent human resources who will then contribute towards the growth of the Cambodia nation. Since started up to present Mengly J. Quach Foundation has supported 65 students who are MJQE's staff and also outsiders.

Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library Project

Mengly J. Quach Mobile Library Project is an outreach project implemented by MJQ Foundation for those who are unable to use such facilities in marginal areas in Cambodia. The mobile library project is designed to serve the communities in areas which are geographically isolated due to difficulties experienced in using the ones available at the stationed branches. So far, MJQ Mobile Library has conducted these programs many times in various provinces in Cambodia. Since then, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has conducted Mobile Library through:

- Provides study materials such as school bag, writing book, pen pencil, ruler, rubber
- Provided reading book in Khmer and English to library at school, NGO and other institution
- Conducted 67 Mobile Library Events to students/ children in NGO and stated school in the rural area through reading, drawing and coloring together with fund activities
- Build/renovate library at school for students.

Teaching and Learning Quality Project

The Teaching and Learning Quality Project is one of 06 new educational program projects developed by the Mengly J. Foundation in early 2019 and was officially launched by Dr. Quach Mengly, Executive Director of the Mengly J. Foundation. on June 11, 2019. This project aims to encourage students and children in the community to be eager to study and learn to promote and enhance the education sector in Cambodia. Since the establishment of this project, the Mengly J. Foundation provided activities such as providing computers, LCD projectors, information boards, study chairs, student uniforms, teaching materials, office supplies, building toilets, water wells, reservoirs, flower gardens in the school, benefiting a total of 10,138 beneficiaries. Kampong Cham, Kampong Chhnang, Pursat, Prey Veng, Kratie, Kampong Thom and Phnom Penh.

We work to link up health initiatives to ensure the students we support are healthy to pursue their education. In addition to that, the MJQ Foundation supports several health activities outside of its core focus that directly address poverty by providing health services to communities where necessary, or lack any health service support. The main purpose of MJQ Health Program is to aim in contributing highly improved health facilities for strengthening the quality of health services and accessibility of the vulnerable family and community.

PROJECTS

Health Emergency Responses Project

Mengly J. Quach Foundation started the first health emergency response project on January 10, 2012. This project aims to help promote a healthy lifestyle in some communities across Cambodia. Mengly J. Quach Foundation has been working to integrate health initiatives to ensure that the poorest students, women, the elderly, orphans and the most vulnerable receive access to better medical care and health care. Until now, Mengly J. Quach Foundation responded to the health emergency by providing support to the treatment of more than 385,768 patients, including breast cancer patients, heart patients, gonorrhea patients, gynecologists, and traffic accidents.

PRIOR REMARKS

January-December 2021

1,923 Beneficiaries of Communities Service Program received financial support and material for their daily survival:

1,513 Beneficiaries of MJQ Food Banking Project received foodstuff support for their daily survival and basic needs.

294 Beneficiaries of Gift In Kinds Project received material support for their home necessities, such as furniture, mattresses, tables, and kitchen equipment .

106 Beneficiaries of Emergency Responses Project received financial support and materials for their daily survival.

10 Beneficiaries of Emergency Responses Project, especially widows, elders and disables monthly received financial support for their daily survival.

PROJECTS

Emergency Responses Project

Originally named the Community Services Project, it was established during 2004 and 2007 the Mengly J. Quach Foundation donated \$ 5,000 each to the Cambodian Red Cross to meet the needs of the poor and helpless. Since the inception of this project, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation provided assistance to a total of 6,074 beneficiaries, including the provision of food, clothing, medicine to widows, orphans and the elderly.

Later in 2019, the Mengly J. Quach Foundation studied and changed the name of the Community Service Project to an Emergency Response Project under the Community Service Program, which was officially approved by Dr. Quach Mengly, Executive Director of the Mengly J. Quach Foundation on June 11, 2019. In the past, the project has responded with a number of emergencies, such as providing food and materials to poor families who are starving, subsidizing monthly meals for needy students, etc.

MJQ Food Banking Project

This project is our hunger-relief program designed to promote the culture of sharing in the community in Cambodia. MJQ Food Banking aims at increasing access to clean, healthy and nutritious meals to our communities with high poverty rate, and fostering education on proper hygiene and eating behavior, and building a community where food wastage and food surplus are balanced. Since its formation, the project has conducted nearly 258 charitable food donation events, serving more than 135,371 beneficiaries in Cambodia.

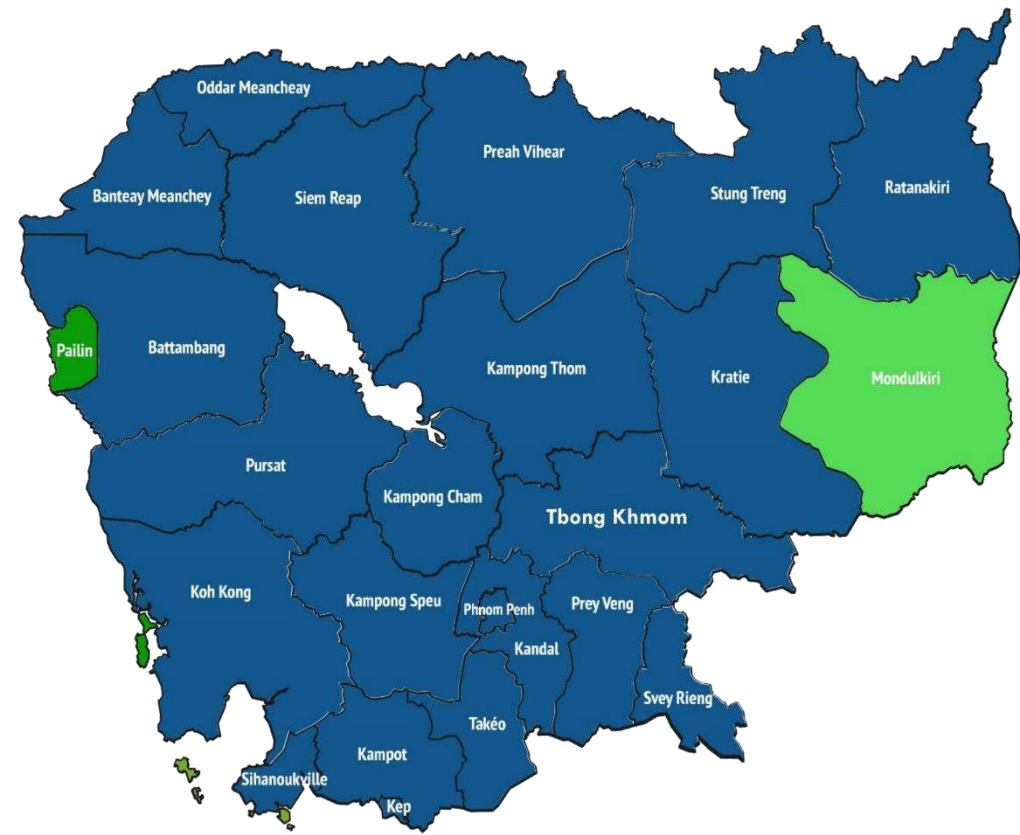
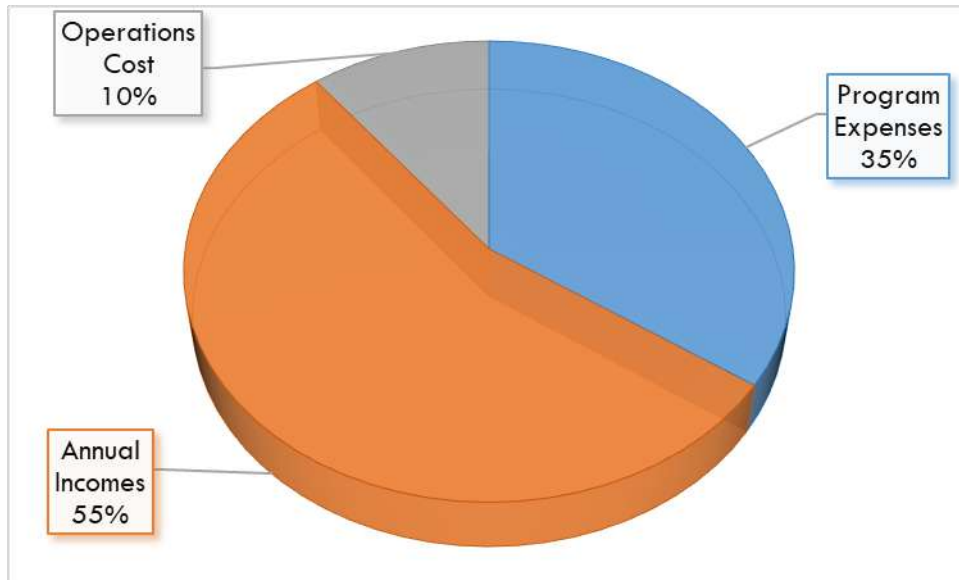
- Responding to COVID-19 outbreaking in communities, MJQ Foundation donated cash and foodstuffs such as rice, instant noodles, soy sauce, fish sauce, canned fish and masks to 1,447 beneficiaries in Phnom Penh, Tbong Khmom and Kandal provinces
- MJQ Foundation, in December 2021, donated some delicious porridge and some learning materials to 66 orphanage children who are living in New Smile of Hope Children Association at Kandal province.



FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The total expenses of Mengly J. Quach Foundation in 2021 is USD97,258.27 for operating its activities and operation cost which these core funds were annually donated from Mengly J. Quach Education at approximately 50% (fifty percent) amount while the rest 50% (fifty percent) amount of funds is from Q & Q.

Anyway, to ensure the financial stability, Mengly J. Quach Foundation has cooperated with teachers/students and relevant units/departments within Mengly J. Quach Education initiates some fundraising activities for earning as extra income. The annual incomes from various donations and fundraising activities for 2021 are totalling at USD118,157.03.



WHERE WE WORK

We have implemented 4 Programs in 24 provinces across Cambodia, including Phnom Penh, Kampong Cham, Kandal, Takeo, Kampot, Kep, Svay Rieng, Prey Veng, Kampong Speu, Koh Kong, Preah Sihanouk, Tbong Khmum, Battambang, Kratie, Pursat, Siem Reap, Banteay Meanchey, Oddar Meanchey, Preah Vihear, Stung Treng, Kampong Thom, Kampong Chhnang and Rattanak Kiri provinces.
